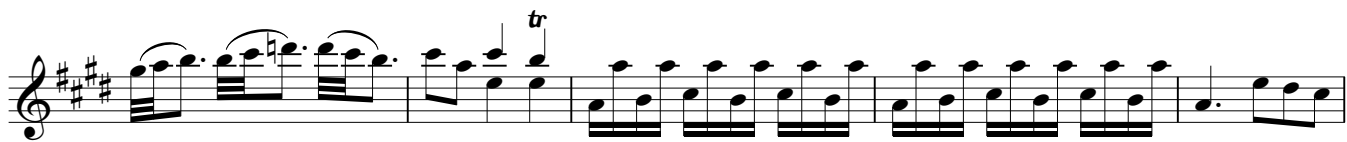
FANTASIA IN E MAJOR

Piacevolmente

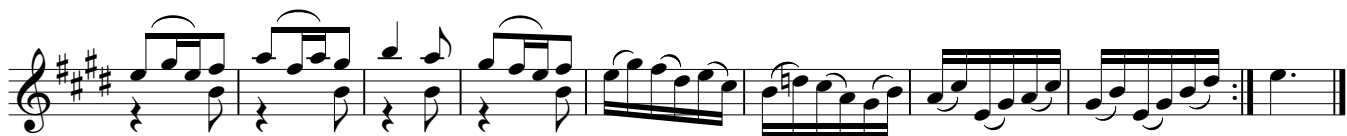
